This historic site is sure to be interesting to anyone who loves trains and the history of steam powered locomotives. Located in the heart of Scranton,

Pennsylvania, Steamtown National Historic Site preserves, interprets, and protects the history of steam railroading in America including the historic railroad yard, collections, technical knowledge, and skills that further the public understanding of the impact of

steam railroading on U.S. industry, commerce, and society.



Discover the history of steam locomotives and the anthracite railroads by watching the 18-minute orientation film "Steel and Steam" and browse through the History Museum. Explore the Roundhouse and get an up close and personal look at the rolling stock. Be in the "room where it happens" and join a park ranger or volunteer on a guided tour of Steamtown's Locomotive Repair Shop. Find that perfect souvenir from our Park Store to capture your Steamtown experience or give as a gift to a train aficionado. Last, but certainly not least, hop on board our seasonal short train rides or longer train excursions for the ultimate hands on Steamtown experience.
