

## MIDWEST ANTIQUES AND COLLECTIBLES

English, IN was originally called Hartford, and under the latter name was laid out in 1839. When the town incorporated in 1886 it was renamed English for William Hayden English, an Indiana politician of the day. On December 28, 1893, the county seat of Crawford County was relocated from Leavenworth to English.

From 1959 to 1990, English suffered six floods. The town council decided that the only solution to the flooding problem was to move the town. 160 acres (0.65 km2) of high ground were purchased, a partnership was formed with Lincoln Hills Development Corporation, and the entire town was relocated. This was the second-largest relocation of an entire town in U.S. history.

several small outbuildings full. They have refinished antique furniture


and rough furniture as well. The larger items may not fit so well in a Porsche, but they will ship it to you!




## Approximately 30 minutes

- **1.** Upon leaving the French Lick Resort turn onto **IN-145 South**.
- 2. Follow IN-145 S past Patoka Lake
- 3. When IN-145 S turns right, stay straight on IN-64 E
- **4.** You will observe **Pappy's** gas station on the right.
- **5.** Turn left onto **IN-64 E/ IN-37** (A green sign will point left for "English")
- 6. Continue to follow IN-64 E/IN-37 into English, IN.

- 1. Head southwest on IN-64 W
- 2. Turn right at green exit sign indicating "To I-64" on the ramp you will see a green sign for "Paoli."
- 3. At end of ramp turn left onto IN-37 N
- 4. At light in downtown Paoli, IN just after Paoli Dairyland, turn left onto IN-56 W/US-150 W
- 5. Follow IN-56 W back into French Lick
