




2022 Porsche Parade Michelin Autocross Pocono Raceway June 15th and 16th



Dear AutoX Participant,

Based on actual registrations for the 2022 Pocono Parade AutoX your PCA AutoX team has refined schedules and logistics to make your AutoX experience smoother, more time efficient, and more fun. There will be only 2 groups per day. As soon as Group #1 finishes their four runs there will be a 30 minute restroom and worker change period then Group #2 will run. With everyone's cooperation, Group 1 could finish as early as 10:30am and Group 2 by about 1:00pm. Same for Groups #3 and #4. Please read the below updates that supersede the pre-printed information in your Parade Registration package:

Run and Work Schedule (supersedes all other schedules)

- You must compete in the proper run group for your car's class. There will be no exceptions made for those who have personal conflicts or conflicts with other Parade activities. Men's and women's classes run together.
- Each driver must sign up to work.** This began in 2019 and is typical at AutoX events. Please sign up for a work assignment at check-in on Sunday. We will accommodate physical limitations, talk to us. Work sessions should only be ~ 1.5-2.5 hours.
- While Group 1 runs, Group 2 works. Then there will be a 30 minute break before Group 2 runs and Group 1 works. Impound will be back in pre-grid after both groups are finished running. The same will apply for Groups 3 and 4.
- All participants must attend the 8:15am drivers' meeting** on the day they run.



Parking, Transportation & Facilities

Paddock parking at the AutoX site for participants will be inside the track in the garage area, look for the sign. Parking for workers and spectators will also be in the track garage area, look for the sign. The Garage Grill will be open from 7:30am to 2:30pm and will take cash and credit cards. There is no shuttle to the AutoX site.



Check-In & Safety Inspection

You must complete Parade Check-In no later than the day before the AutoX event starts so you can sign the waiver and receive your car numbers. Also, your car must pass a safety inspection before you compete in the AutoX. Tech will be done in pre-grid before you run. Your car must be presented ready to run.

Changes to Car Class

Changes to your car classification should be done at Parade Check-In. Last minute car class changes must be done prior to 1:00 pm Tuesday, June 14, which is the day before the start of the autocross event. Only the AutoX Protest Committee can approve class change requests after that time. Entrants are encouraged to bring classification issues to the attention of the AutoX Chair or a PCR committee member for corrective action. We would prefer to be proactive in fixing classing issues before the event rather than impose penalties after the fact. Also, see section G-8 in the PCRs. However, even if you receive our advice, classification is still your responsibility.

AutoX Site Directions and Noise Limit

The Parade AutoX will be held at the Pocono International Raceway (1234 Long Pond Road, Long Pond, PA 18334) which is about a 20-minute, 11.5-mile drive from the Kalahari Resort. **Gates open at 7:00am.** To get there, head south on Kalahari Blvd; right to stay on Kalahari Blvd.; turn left on PA-314 W; turn left onto the ramp to Blakeslee; merge onto PA-940 W; turn left onto Stoney Hollow Rd; turn right onto Long Pond Road; enter the track at "Gate 1"; stop at the guard stand and show your name tag (**you cannot get in without your name tag**); follow signs to parking. There is no sound level limit, however, we are following the local "good neighbor" policy by not allowing open exhausts.

Chalk Talk and Course Walk

There will be a Michelin AutoX "Chalk Talk" on Tuesday, June 14, from 3:00 to 4:00 pm in the classroom at Pocono International Raceway. This talk is open to everyone but will be geared toward novice/intermediate drivers. In addition, experienced instructors will give guided course walks and provide advice on what to expect at the event from 2:00 to 5:00 pm. You will have an opportunity to ask questions and get tips about the course. For those who are unable to walk the course, a golf cart ride at walking speed will be available.

The AutoX course will be open for walking as follows:

Tuesday, June 14	2:00 to 5:00 pm (also Instructor lead walks 2:00pm - 5:00pm)
Wednesday, June 15	7:00 to 8:00 am (also after Wed AutoX runs for one hour, be there by ~ 12:00pm)
Thursday, June 16	7:00 to 8:00 am

An in-car video run of the course will be available on the Parade website or YouTube.
