
# 2022 Porsche Parade Gimmick Rally Drivers Meeting June 16, 2022

#### **Overview of Gimmick Rally Timeline**



- Attend advance Zoom Driver's Safety Meeting (check √)
- Sign Up Genius: Confirm your navigator and passengers by name and select your Out-Time online (by the minute), in advance
- Check in at the GR table at Registration on Sunday, June 12th
- Arrive at Barley Creek Brewing Company (BCBC) on June 16<sup>th</sup> "Ready to Rally" <u>20 minutes prior to your out-time departure.</u>
- Enjoy the Roads and Rally Gimmick, turning in your score sheet before 4:30 PM
- Scores and answers posted Friday afternoon, 17 June, prior to the Autocross Awards Banquet

Click on the link provided by email and select a time, then click Submit and Sign Up. You will need to know the entrant numbers of the driver and navigator, and how many passengers you will have. SAVE the email you will get from them with the link to review your out-time! Yes, you can change it.

Your Entrant number is your Parade Number, such as 18A and 18B, 18J, 18G, etc.

### What to Bring



#### • Your sense of humor! Fun times ahead! 😊

• Download & print the General Instructions and Activities rules (will also be in your packet)

Which will be emailed to you, and available on-line on the PCA Parade GR webpage. Print, review and bring to Parade with you. Ask any questions!

• Cell phone or Car GPS –

You will be given a simple map and addresses, and a prescribed order in which to visit 9 checkpoints. Please navigate by in-car GPS or a phone GPS app. Mileage doesn't count in this rally.

- Dress for comfort rain or shine
  - × You will be getting in and out of the car, walking short distances, and participating in some easy games. Bring a hat, sunscreen, umbrella, etc.
- Bring a clipboard, pencils, pens & some cash \$

You will pass over a privately owned historic toll bridge between PA and NJ, where an attendant will collect \$1 each way. No credit cards ☺

• Stops along the way:

-Food and fuel will be available at various places along the way, noted in your instructions. BCBC will have coffee in the AM for us and have excellent food & beverage for your post rally enjoyment. Bring some water and snacks.



#### Registration Check In Sunday, June 12th



• Check in at the GR table at Registration:

Confirm your Class, including names of navigator and passengers
Confirm your Sign Up Genius out-time
Confirm your attendance (mandatory), or on-line viewing of one of two Driver's Safety meetings.
Pick up last-minute instructions.

#### Gimmick Rally Day – The Start June 16th



- Arrival: Arrive 20 minutes prior to your selected Out Time. Note: if you arrive prior to your 20-minute window, you will be turned away and diverted to another park & wait location. If you arrive without a navigator, you will be turned away. No exceptions. Arrive ready to drive with a full tank.
- **Staging:** Pick up your packet (route instructions, score sheet, etc) at our Check-In Pavilion. You may begin looking through your packet immediately!
- Departure: Follow the directions in your packet Entrants will be doing the routes and activities in different sequences to spread out the cars. Line up to depart five minutes before your out time.
- Cars will be sent out every minute, so it is VERY important that you keep to the schedule! Be in line ready to go at your out time. Don't dawdle at the games, keep the event moving, please! (Follow directions of our workers at all times.)



#### Gimmick Rally Day June 16th



**Out-times:** First car off at 8:00 PM. Cars will be sent at one-minute intervals. Please be on time, but not too early! The route is approximately 92 miles long and takes 2 hours 25 minutes to drive without stops. Plan on about 5 hours to complete the rally.

**End Point:** BCBC (same as start point) Enjoy some of their tasty food and beverages as a reward for your efforts! (You may need it!)

Turning in Score Cards: Drop off your score sheets at our BCBC Pavilion. You will answer the Tie-breaker question here and record it on your scorecard. We will not be scoring you at drop-off; please don't ask.

**Parking:** BCBC will be a beehive of activity, with cars coming and going all day long. The same will be true of our 'activity' checkpoints. Please be sensible, patient, and follow the directions of our volunteers at all times.





**Concept:** Your goal is to enjoy the scenery and roads, finish the rally, participate in eight of nine activities for points, and complete our Porsche Bingo Matching card at a total of 9 Checkpoints using the Route Instructions provided – all while having FUN!

#### The Activities– Part 1:

The rally features 9 different activities/games that were played back in the day at the old Pocono family resorts. None are dangerous, strenuous or demanding. Just some old-fashioned fun.

Some of your checkpoints will have more than one activity. Some will have none and will be only a Bingo stop. Each activity checkpoint will be manned by volunteers who will be controlling traffic and acting as a facilitators/referees for the games. Please follow their directions and instructions so you can park, play, and exit safely and successfully.

#### The Activities (Eight of Nine)

You will be able to accumulate up to 20 points at each activity. The Check Point Captain will monitor and score your activity. The rules and points for each of the activities will be distributed with the General Instructions. (If you are really competitive, start practicing now, except of course for the Blind Man's Autocross! ;-))





**Concept:** Complete your Porsche Bingo Matching card using Porsche stickers you will acquire at each check point along the Rally.

Porsche Bingo Matching – Part 2:

Not every checkpoint will feature an activity. Some will be scenic locations or attractions where you will be required to pick up a sticker to match to a Porsche image on your Porsche Bingo card. There will be a total of 9 Porsche stickers.

The "Bingo only" locations will feature something unique from the Delaware Water Gap area for you to enjoy – from the natural world, local history or the arts. Take a few moments to enjoy!

A short walk to a waterfall, a Nature Center and a Crafts Center Gallery...





Score Card: The total points you will be able to accumulate is 180.

Activities: 8 Activities or Games – 20 points max for each, partial points for each. We encourage everyone in the car to take turns participating, including Juniors!

Bingo: Collect all 9 stickers for 20 points, but no partial points, it is all or nothing. © Each check point location will feature its own sticker. Take ONE sticker as proof that you visited the check point and affix it the matching image on your Bingo card.

We will also feature our now traditional tie-breaker question at the end of the rally, just in case.



#### Gimmick Rally Day – The Route Instructions & Safety Part 1



This rally route uses some of the most scenic Porsche roads in and around the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area (DWGNRA).

This rally route uses some of the most scenic Porsche roads in and around the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area (DWGNRA). Route Instructions will consist of:

a) a Google Directions route map identifying three general areas in the DWGNRA where the checkpoints will be concentrated (with names and addresses)
b) a list of these checkpoints in <u>the specific order</u> you will visit them.

You are encouraged to navigate by GPS or WAZE, or similar. On the route, you will pass over the Delaware River on an historic wooden bridge that is privately owned (one of only a few left). A toll charge of \$1 is collected each way, so please have some cash at the ready. <sup>(i)</sup>



#### Gimmick Rally Day – The Route Instructions & Safety Part 1



To offset lines and traffic jams at the Game/Activity Checkpoints, multiple route instructions will be issued on an alternating basis. You may see Porsches going the other way or go by an Activity Checkpoint enroute and think you will be missing it. But we can assure you that your instructions will bring you back to it. (Note: This means that every car will be on its own route. DO NOT FOLLOW THE CAR IN FRONT OF YOU.) You must follow your own route instructions to be scored.

There may be a wait for some of the activity check points. If we've done our instructions right, the queues will be short. There are two sets of games at most locations. Be patient, follow instructions of our volunteers and enjoy the day. By the same token, please keep the process moving (each game should take 5 minutes or less) so that the lines stay short, and everyone can enjoy their experience throughout the day (including the volunteers!).



#### Gimmick Rally Day – The Route Instructions & Safety Part 1



Your Route Instructions will note locations for Restrooms and Food at or near the Checkpoints (most have restrooms). You will pass by areas with fuel and fast food as well. We encourage you to sample the food and beverage at Barley Creek Brewing Company after you complete the rally. They will also be providing coffee in the morning.

Please remember to thank our local host locations, as they are freely loaning us their facilities and equipment! Please thank our hard-working Parade volunteers!

# **Gimmick Rally Day – Activity Check Points**



- Please drive into the check point at 5 MPH and follow the directions of the volunteers and parking attendants upon arrival.
- Although you will be provided the rules and points scoring in your packet, your Check Point Captain will read the rules to you and ask if you have any questions before beginning the game/activity.
- •
- You will be allowed a practice volley or shot in selected activities, for example shuffleboard. At each activity, you can decide who will compete, if you have more than 2 people. We encourage everyone to take turns! Most games require 2 people. You are only "competing" against yourself for points, not other teams.
- •
- Each activity should take only a few minutes to complete. There are no do-overs. Your Captain will score you and initial your scorecard upon completion. Please do not argue or challenge your score... or offer bribes! ③ But please DO thank our hard-working volunteers!
- Please exit the checkpoint safely and watch for oncoming traffic.



#### **Gimmick Rally Day – Porsche Bingo**



**Porsche Bingo Matching:** Bingo will have you visiting some of the more scenic locations and/or interesting attractions in the DWGNRA along your route. Each check point location will feature its own Porsche sticker. Visit all checkpoints in the order you are assigned.

Take ONE sticker as proof that you visited the check point and affix it the matching image on your Porsche Bingo Matching Card. There will be a total of nine checkpoints, and, hence, nine stickers to acquire on the Rally. Complete your Porsche Bingo Matching Card (worth 20 points) and turn it in with your Score Card at the end of the Rally.





### **Gimmick Rally Scoring**



- Ensure your names, car entrant number and class are clearly marked on the answer sheet, and on your Bingo Card. Don't forget to answer the Tie-Breaker Question when you turn in your Cards!
- Turn in your Rally Scorecard no later than 4:30 PM at the Gimmick Rally Pavilion at BCBC. There will be NO activity scorecards scored at BCBC, sorry!
- Results will be posted on the Parade Website on Friday afternoon, as available.
- Trophies will be awarded for Two-Person, Two-Person Plus Pasengers, and PCA Juniors@Parade classes at the Autocross Banquet on Friday night, June 17th
