



**Destination Drive to Jim Thorpe, PA and the Lehigh Gorge Scenic Railway (LGSRY):**

For those who were unable to register for the Lehigh Gorge/Jim Thorpe guided tour or were unable to deconflict with other Parade events, you can still make this drive on your own. The Victorian town of Jim Thorpe, named after one of the most famous American athletes of all time, is consistently ranked on national media "Best" lists and recognized among the most fun, most beautiful, most romantic and best adventure town to visit. Jim Thorpe consists of many small shops and restaurants as well as interesting sights with tours. Restaurant choices include: Molly Maguire's Pub and Steakhouse (570) 325-4563, Broadway Grill and Pub (570) 732-4343, and Marion Hose Bar (570) 732-1968. Make sure to check their hours of operation. Tour spots include St. Mark's Church and the Asa Packer Mansion.



One of the main attractions in Jim Thorpe is the Lehigh Gorge Scenic Railway tour for a scenic narrated ride through the Lehigh Gorge. This 70 minute ride in open sided or covered train cars offers great panoramic views along the entire route. Train tours depart at 11 AM, 1 PM and 3 PM.



Train tour prices:

Closed car: \$17 Adult, \$9 Child (3-12), <2 free, but must have a ticket

Open car: \$20 Adult, \$10 Child (3-12), <2 free but must have a ticket

Parking is very limited in Jim Thorpe, so be ready to spend some time looking for a spot. There is public parking across from the train station if it is not full. Price is \$8. The Visitor's Center is in the train station and is a good place to stop first to learn where to go.
