Overview of the Shake 'n Bake Gimmick Rally Timeline



1. Attend advance Zoom Driver's Safety Meeting (check ✓)
2. Sign Up Genius: Select your Out-Time online (by the minute), between Thursday, May 30 @ 9AM ET - Friday, June 7th. Enter Navigator name & details
3. Check in at the GR table at Registration on Sunday, June 9th
4. Arrive at Porsche Birmingham on June 13th "Ready to Rally" 15 minutes prior to your out-time departure.
5. Enjoy the Rally, Museums, Track and Gimmick, turning in your score sheet before 5:00 PM at Saw's BBQ.
6. Scores and answers posted Friday afternoon, June 14th, prior to the trophy presentations at the Autocross Awards Banquet



Registration Check In Sunday, June 9th



Check in at the GR table at Registration:

- Confirm your Class, including names of navigator and passengers
(Do you need a navigator or driver? Let us know! 2 people minimum per car)
- Confirm your SignUp Genius out-time
- Confirm your attendance (mandatory), or on-line viewing of one of two Driver's Safety meetings.
- Pick up final instructions handout.

Classes:

- Two Person (Driver and Navigator)
- Two Plus (Driver, Navigator and 1+ passengers (any age))
- PCA Juniors@Parade (Driver, Navigator and 1+ registered Juniors@Parade passengers)
- Note – Navigators can be 13 and older



Sign Up Genius



- Use online SignUp Genius to select your departure Out Time

- **Opens Thursday, 5/30 at 9:00 AM ET and closes Friday, 6/7 at 9:00 AM ET**
 - Click on the link provided by email and select a time, then click Submit and Sign Up.
 - You will register with your name, email and phone number
 - You will need to know the entrant numbers of the driver and navigator, and how many passengers you will have.
 - Your Entrant number is your Parade Number, such as 18A and 18B, 18J, 18G, etc.
 - **SAVE the email** you will get from SignUp Genius with the link to review your out-time!
 - Yes, you can change it to any open slot up until sign ups close.
 - **Note: if rallying with friends, sign up with times near each other. Every 10 minutes, there will be one slot for 2 cars/minute (to allow all cars to depart in 3 hours or less)**
 - It does not matter what vehicle you drive, it is ok to change to a different car



Shake 'n Bake Gimmick Rally What to Bring



- **Your sense of adventure! Fun times ahead! 😊**
- Cell phone or Car GPS –
 - You will be given written route instructions. You can also navigate by GPS. Mileage does not count for scoring in this rally.
 - Yes, you are encouraged to use the internet to find answers to questions.
- Dress for comfort.
 - All participants **must wear their name badges** at all times. You will be required to leave your car multiple times to complete the gimmick.
- Bring a clipboard and pens or pencils.
 - You will be making notes and answering questions along the route.
- Stops along the way:
 - There are many options for food, shopping, sight-seeing and fuel. (including Buc-ee's)
 - There are 4 stops required to solve the Gimmick.
- A camera/cell phone for MANY cool photos and videos!



Gimmick Rally Day

June 13 – Porsche Birmingham



Arrival: Arrive 15 minutes prior to your selected Out Time. You MUST have a navigator to do this rally. Arrive ready to drive (no breakfast this year). Follow directions of our volunteers to park.

Staging: Pick up your packet (route instructions, score sheet, etc) at the Check-in table inside Porsche Birmingham. You may begin looking through your packet right away. Everyone MUST wear their Parade name badges on this rally.

Departure: Line up to depart five minutes before your out time. (See map) Cars will be sent out one per minute. Be in line ready to go at your out time.

The Route



Route: The Shake 'n Bake Rally route is approximately 85 miles long and takes about 2.5 hours to drive without stops. There are 4 required stops, 3 of them with specific details to know.

- 1. The Mustang Museum** – over 100 Mustangs with almost every make and model plus the largest collection of Highway Patrol and rare SSP Mustangs in the US. Also including many famous movie Mustangs and their stories, and Mustang Pace Cars. Also a special Porsche GT3 RS race car makes an appearance. 😊

- 2. IMHOF – International Motorsports Hall of Fame Museum** - the Museum rotunda is also used for Superspeedway ticket sales and holds the Museum gift shop. The Museum showcases racing history, and the men and women who are the legends of the sport.

3. Talladega Superspeedway

- Everyone will enter through the Main Gate. Staff will check off names of those doing laps and mark your car windshield.
- Everyone follows the marked roadway and directions of staff. Everyone will park by the garages; wander the garages, take photos in Victory Circle and from the Tower, see historic race films, take more fun photos.... Bathrooms available, no refreshments at the track. Don't forget to look for Gimmick clues!
- Cars doing laps will follow staff directions to drive to Pit Road to line up when you are ready. Laps from 10 AM to 4:30 PM
- Approx. 5-15 cars per group as you line up, 6 laps divided into 2 sets of 3.
- Drivers & passengers can change at the swap.
- No passing! Do not use the top lane.
- Want more laps? Pay on site credit card only
- Must be back to Saw's BBQ by 5:00 PM
- Yes, these are the same laps as Friday's Tour





Gimmick Rally Day

Safety



1. We are guests at all our stops, please be respectful of all property and support our local partners.
2. “Gimmick Safety” – Do not touch, move or harm any items you see that are Gimmick clues or connected to completing the Gimmick. Thank you!
3. Drive safely and observe speed limits on public roads.
4. Watch for road signs carefully, there are not a lot out there! (ie: road names and speed limits)
5. 3-way stops can be confusing, be cautious!
6. Trucks and Semis on the highways can be very fast and reckless, best to let them have their way.
